## **FAQ**

- Q What are the side effects?
- A Apart from mild swelling and possible bruising, patients may resume their normal daily activities immediately after receiving the treatment.
- Q For how long does the result last?
- A Visible results can be observed immediately after the treatment and will continue to improve over the next two to six months, accompanied with new collagen production on the treated areas. Threads will slowly dissolve completely, but the result will last for at least a year or more.
- Q Can I get other treatments along with PDO threads?
- A Yes, it is possible to achieve better results when accompanied with filler, Botox, HIFU, and etc.

### BENEFITS OF THREAD LIFTING

VIOLA Threads provide medical aesthetic practitioners with various types of fully absorbable threads that come in different shapes, sizes, and even materials including PDO, PLLA, and PCL. Our PDO threads are US-FDA 510K approved (#K190264) for barbed sutures, consisting of dyed polydioxanone (PDO) and indicated for use in soft tissue approximation, where the use of absorbable suture is appropriate.

#### **Thread Lifting**

Thread lifting is a minimally invasive procedure that uses needles and blunt tip cannulas to deliver fully absorbable surgical sutures deep into the skin tissue. As the the thread is tightened, the skin tissue can get pulled and anchored into desired directions. Thread lifting is a nonsurgical alternative to the face lift surgery.

#### **Collagen Formation**

Following a thread lift using VIOLA Threads, there is new collagen formation in the dermal matrix. This inherently improves the appearance of pores and fine wrinkles.



# The lifting effect of a thread lift can help:

- Smooth out fine wrinkles and folds
- Uplift sagging skin for a more youthful appearance
- Reduce the appearance of jawline and drooping cheeks

#### **Treatment Time**

The treatment time of a thread lift procedure will vary based on many different factors — size of the needles used and the types of treatment areas. On average, the treatment takes approximately 20 - 40 minutes to complete after the application of topical or local anesthesia.
